KWC Tennis Team Behavior Code

In order for all participants to have a positive experience playing on the tennis team, we require that parents and/or guardians read the following behavior policy with their participating children. By signing the policy, you indicate that you and your participating children understand the guidelines, agree to abide by them and accept the consequences of a failure to abide by them.

1. Tennis players shall behave respectfully towards the Tennis Coach, the Assistant Coach(es), and any adults assisting in program-related activities during practice or at competitions. Respectful behavior includes listening while coaches speak, following instructions, and following the rules of all games as stated by the coaches. Arguing with coaches will not be tolerated.

2. Tennis players shall not throw objects or equipment while on the courts, nor hit tennis balls at other participants (including coaching staff). Dangerous actions will not be tolerated.

3. Tennis players shall behave respectfully toward one another. Name-calling, pushing, and any other aggressive verbal or physical contact will not be tolerated.

4. All tennis players will participate in retrieving balls both on the courts and outside the fence.

Consequences:

If the Tennis Coaches witness inappropriate or dangerous behavior, they have the authority to ask a player to leave the courts for a period of time that they determine to be appropriate. If a player repeatedly behaves in a manner deemed unsafe or disrespectful, that player may be suspended from one or more practices, from competitions, or may be dismissed from the tennis program entirely. No refunds will be issued due to suspension or dismissal.
